

Low-Income Heating Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) Income Guidelines

The total household income for an applicant must be at or below 150 percent of the 2014 federal poverty guidelines which are listed below:

1	\$4,376	\$17,505
2	\$5,899	\$23,595
3	\$7,421	\$29,685
4	\$8,944	\$35,775
5	\$10,466	\$41,865
6	\$11,989	\$47,955

(For households with more than six members, add \$1,523 per 3 months or \$6,090 annually for each additional member)

*Households who are over LIHEAP regular income guidelines may be eligible for LIHEAP benefits through the medical waiver component. The medical expenses must be documented, paid, & non-reimbursable. For more information, contact your local community action agency.

Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) Income Guidelines (April 1, 2015-March 31, 2016)

The total household income for an applicant must be at or below 200 percent of the 2015 federal poverty guidelines which are listed below:

<u>Size of Household</u>	<u>Three Month Gross Income*</u>	<u>Annual Gross Income*</u>
1	\$5,885	\$23,540
2	\$7,965	\$31,860
3	\$10,045	\$40,180
4	\$12,125	\$48,500
5	\$14,205	\$56,820
6	\$16,285	\$65,140

* For households with more than six members, add \$2,080 for a three-month period or \$8,320 annually for each additional member.

NOTE: If the household is receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Family Investment Program (FIP) Assistance, the household is eligible to receive Weatherization services, regardless of income.
