The University of Iowa, School of Social Work seeks a clinical assistant professor (12-month appointment) to direct the field education program, teach, and engage in professional productivity and service. The School offers programs at the B.A., M.S.W., and Ph.D. levels with faculty scholarship foci in the areas of aging, child welfare, mental health, and culturally competent social work practice. In addition to programs on our main Iowa City campus, we offer a BASW program in Des Moines, and MSW programs in Des Moines, Quad Cities and Sioux City. We are seeking a person to provide leadership for the field education program, including administering the Iowa City field education program and working collaboratively with field education administrators at our distance education sites. Required qualifications:

- MSW from a CSWE accredited program.
- A minimum of three years post-graduate level practice experience.
- Demonstrated potential for teaching in social work.
- Demonstrated potential for integrating human diversity and cultural competence in teaching, administration or service.
- Experience in administration or program development.
- Potential for professional productivity through such activities as conference presentations, professional consultation, outreach activities, publications, membership on state or regional boards or professional organizations.

- Knowledge of Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) Educational Policy and Academic Standards pertaining to field education.
- LMSW or LISW (or equivalent) social work licensure in current state of residence/employment.
